- Be a 3rd year premed student with plans to apply to medical school in 2020;
- Possess a competitive GPA;
- Have a strong interest in pursuing primary care;
- Submit one (1) letter of recommendation from a college faculty;
- Submit an unofficial copy of your transcript.
